HOW TO REACH BOLZANO

By plane

The closest airports to Bolzano/Bozen offering international connections are **Innsbruck 'Kranebitten' Airport (INN)** in Austria and **Verona Airport 'V. Catullo' (VRN)** in Italy, both are located approx. 2 hours by shuttle bus + train and 1,5 hours by car from Bolzano/Bozen.

For intercontinental flights we recommend:

- Munich International Airport (MUC), Germany, located 4,5 hours by speed train (trains running from the airport) and 3 hours by car from Bolzano/Bozen. At certain times of the day there are direct shuttle busses running between Munich Airport and Bolzano/Bozen, please check on http://www.rauchreisen.de/en/suedtirol-bus-flughafen/
- Milan ('Malpensa' Airport MXP and 'Linate' Airport LIN), Italy. The travel time to Bolzano/Bozen is approx. 4 hours by airport shuttle bus + train from 'Milano Centrale' or 3 hours by car.
- Venice 'Marco Polo' Airport (VCE), Italy. The travel time is approx. 3,5 hours by airport shuttle bus + train from 'Venezia Mestre' or 2,5 hours by car.

The local **Airport Bolzano Dolomiti (BZO**) can be reached via **Rome Fiumicino** (three times a day).

By train

Regular train services are available from main Austrian, German and Italian cities.

There are direct trains to and from Munich - Innsbruck and Verona – Bologna – Firenze – Roma.

Traintickets:

Please note that in Italy train tickets (both purchased online at www.trenitalia.com or at the ticket office) have to be validated at the grey-green machines that can be found at the train station before departure. Be aware that it is not possible to buy tickets on board of trenitalia trains (regionale or freccia).

On the other hand, tickets for the EC fast trains managed by ÖBB/LeNord can be purchased on the websites www.oebb.at or www.db.de, in ticket offices or on board without any additional fee and do not need to be validated prior departure.

By car

Bolzano/Bozen is located on the A22 Brennero-Modena motorway (toll road), which is connected to Munich and Innsbruck to the North and Trento and Verona to the South.
